1. Key Themes from President's Address

Confront the 3! Commit to the 5! Crave the ONE!

Confront the 3!

The Conference continues to face three long-standing challenges: (i) the Young (youth and young adults), (ii) the Aging, and (iii) the Shortage of Pastors. Addressing these challenges requires intentional and sustained effort. Churches are called to build authentic relationships with the Young, invest in mentoring, and provide opportunities for growth and responsibility. Seniors should be valued as reservoirs of faith and wisdom, while also being given meaningful opportunities to serve and contribute to church life. Meeting the pastoral shortage requires identifying and nurturing individuals who sense God's call to pastoral ministry.

Commit to the 5!

Rooted in Acts 2, the 5Ws-Word, Worship, Welcome, Witness, and Wonder serve as essential practices for every church. The Word inspires obedience, shaping believers so that what is preached in the sanctuary is reflected in their daily lives. Worship calls for wholehearted engagement, centring the community on God rather than turning gatherings into performances. Welcome embodies radical hospitality, creating a culture where every person is seen, valued, and loved. Witness challenges believers to live out their faith in daily life, letting their actions, words, and presence point others to Christ. Wonder opens space for God to move in powerful and unexpected ways. When intentionally nurtured, these five practices help congregations thrive spiritually and face the Conference's challenges.

Crave the ONE!

No strategy, programme, or practice can ever replace the essential need for God's presence. This presence has been the lifeline of The Methodist Church in Singapore since its Spirit-led beginnings in 1885. Those beginnings were marked by the arrival of missionaries James Thoburn and William Oldham. The Church's founding through God's leading serves as a reminder that dependence on God must remain central to all ministry and church life. Churches are urged to place Scripture at the centre of their teaching, make prayer the primary avenue for drawing near to God, and seek Him above all else.
