General Questions

1. Where and when is the church camp held?

2. Who can attend the camp?

The church camp is open to all.

3. Can I bring my children for the church camp?

The church camp is open to children of all ages and is a wonderful opportunity for families and their children to bond with each other and with the larger body of Christ.

There will be exciting programmes and activities organised by the Children's Ministry for children between four and 12 years of age. The Children's programme will run concurrently with the English and Mandarin speaker sessions.

Youths aged 13 to 18 can look forward to their own special programmes and activities during the camp.

4. Is it possible to bring my infant or young child under four years to the camp?

Infants and young children under four years of age are welcome to join the camp. Please include their details in the registration form. Baby cots are available in limited numbers and can be provided on request on a first-come first-served basis.

Infants and children under four years old will be able to join their parents at the English and Mandarin sessions at an area specially reserved for families with young children.

While no camp fees are payable for infants and young children below four years of age, please note that there is a charge for infants and young children who require a seat on the coach. The charges are \$60 for a return trip and \$35 for a one-way trip.

5. Is the camp accessible for campers with disabilities and special needs? How about campers with medical conditions?

The hotel facilities are accessible for individuals with mobility challenges. Campers with medical conditions are advised to seek medical clearance before registering for the camp.

If you have mobility challenges, special needs, or a medical condition, please provide details in the "Remarks" section of the registration form so that special consideration can be made when assigning your rooms and planning programmes.

6. How do I register for the camp?

7. Is there a registration deadline?

The Early Bird Promotion ends on 28 February 2026. Camp Registration closes on 15 March 2026.

8. What is the cost for the camp and what does it include?

The camp fee includes accommodation for 3 nights, 3 Breakfasts, 2 Lunches, 2 Dinners, and free flow of water, coffee and tea while speaker sessions are in progress. Also included in the camp fee is a lightweight jacket for adult campers (12 years and above) and a T-shirt for child campers (ages four to 11 years).

Please note that the camp fee excludes transportation. Coach transfers are available at a separate fee of \$60 (two-way) and \$35 (one-way). Campers are to make your own arrangements should you wish to drive or fly.

The camp fee for single occupancy is \$650 (early bird promotional price is \$600).

9. Why is the camp fee not bundled with transport?

We want to give flexibility to campers to decide how they would like to travel to the camp, so we have kept the camp fee separate from transport expenses. Campers are free to consider whether they prefer to take the coach one way or both ways, try the new rail connection from JB Sentral to KL Sentral, fly or self-drive.

Those who wish to book the coach option (one-way or return) may do so at registration.

10. Why are adult campers getting jackets and not T-shirts?

Given that church events, including camps, typically produce T-shirts, we thought a jacket would be a good change and a useful souvenir even after the camp. Do share your feedback in the post-camp survey if you prefer T-shirts for the next camp.

11. How will I choose the size for the jackets and children's T-shirts?

Campers will need to indicate the size of the jackets and children's T-shirts during registration. Sample adult jackets and children's T-shirts in the different sizes will be on display to guide you. You may also check the size charts below:

While payment via electronic modes is strongly encouraged, cash payment will also be accepted for exceptional cases (eg Seniors without banking apps).

13. How will I know if my registration is confirmed?

Upon receipt of payment verified by PLMC Finance, you will receive an email confirming your registration together with the official receipt.

Accommodation

14. I have a family of four (or more) with children of various ages. How will rooming arrangements be made for my family?

Families of four with two children below the age of four years can request for a baby cot to be provided in your double/twin-sharing room (limited numbers & subject to availability).

If your children are between four and 11 years of age and you have selected the option:

a. **Without bed:** No extra bed will be provided in your double/twin sharing room.

b. **With bed:** Your children will be accommodated together with you in a double/twin sharing room or in a connecting room (on best effort basis) or a room nearby.

For families with children between 12 and 25 years of age, your children will be accommodated together with you in a double/twin sharing room or in a connecting room or a room nearby.

15. What are the rooming arrangements for families of three with children?

Families with children below the age of four years can request for a baby cot to be provided in your double/twin-sharing room (limited numbers and subject to availability).

If your children are between four and 11 years of age and you have selected the option:

- a. **Without bed:** No extra bed will be provided in your double/twin-sharing room.
- b. **With bed:** Your children will be accommodated together with you in your double/twin-sharing room with an extra bed.

Children between 12 and 25 years of age will be accommodated together in your double/twin-sharing room with an extra bed.

16. If I am going to the camp alone, can I have a single room? If I prefer to share a room with another camper, will the church arrange for a roommate for me?

You may opt for a single room at \$650 per person (early bird promotion price is \$600).

If you would like to share a room but are unable to find a roommate of the same gender, you may request for assistance from the camp registration team. However, please note that PLMC cannot be held responsible should you be dissatisfied with the roommate assigned to you. As all rooming is pre-allocated before the actual event, we appreciate campers' kind understanding that the committee will not be able to make any changes to rooming during the church camp.

Single campers who wish to have twin-room sharing arrangements, kindly contact us directly via email at plmc.ohana26@gmail.com and provide us with your name, age, gender and contact details (mobile and email).

17. I would like to extend my stay. Am I able to do so?

Yes, you may extend your stay either before or after the camp ("extended stay") by booking directly with Berjaya Times Square Hotel or any other hotel of your choice.

Should you wish to book your extended stay with Berjaya Times Square, you may email plmc.ohana26@gmail.com for the booking form to enjoy a preferential room rate of RM320 nett per night with breakfast for two people.

Please note that rooms assigned for the camp period and rooms provided by Berjaya Times Square Hotel for the extended stay period will not be the same, and campers will need to check-in/out to change rooms accordingly.

Meals and Dietary Requirements

18. Which meals are included in the camp fees?

The following meals are provided for all campers, along with free flow of drinking water, coffee and tea while speaker sessions are in progress.

You will have to make your own arrangements for dinner on 15 June 2026, and lunch on 16 June 2026. Many food options are available in the mall at Berjaya Times Square.

19. Can I make a request for special dietary accommodation due to medical reasons?

You may make your request in the “Remarks” section of the registration form if you have special dietary needs **due to medical reasons**. We will liaise, on best effort basis, with the hotel on your behalf to check if special arrangements can be accommodated. However, if your requirements cannot be met by the hotel, the committee would like to seek your kind understanding.

Getting to the Camp

20. Will transport be provided by PLMC? How do I get to the camp location?

Coach travel: PLMC will be arranging transportation via 45-seater buses at a separate fee. The price is \$60 per person for a return trip and \$35 per person for a one-way trip. The coach journey takes between five and six hours each way, including a 45-minute rest stop at Yong Peng.

The journey will begin from the bus terminal at Kovan Hub and end at Berjaya Times Square Hotel, with the return journey starting from the hotel to Kovan Hub. You may select the coach travel add-on option during registration.

For campers who intend to extend their stay outside of the Ohana Camp period of 14-17 June 2026, please note that the coach transfer arranged by PLMC will not be able to cover such dates. In such instances, do arrange for your own transportation to and/or from the Ohana Camp.

Should you have a change of mind in taking the coach, please inform via email to plmc.ohana26@gmail.com by 15 May 2026 no later than 6pm, stating your name and registration invoice number. Upon approval, we will process a full refund for your transportation within 30 days via PayNow.

21. I prefer to fly to Kuala Lumpur. Can I make my own travel arrangements?

Yes, **flying** is a comfortable and convenient way to get to Kuala Lumpur. Popular carriers providing flights between Singapore Changi Airport and Kuala Lumpur International Airport (KLIA) include Singapore Airlines, Scoot, Malaysia Airlines and AirAsia.

To get to Berjaya Times Square from KLIA, you may take the KLIA Express train to KL Sentral (28 minutes, trains depart every 20 minutes) and transfer to the monorail to Imbi station (six minutes) which is directly linked to Berjaya Times Square KL. You will need to purchase single-trip tickets or tokens for the KLIA Express train and monorail from the ticketing machines at the stations or use the stored value Touch'n Go card. Alternatively, you may take a taxi or private hire vehicle available from Klook or Grab (45 to 60 minutes depending on traffic conditions). Please note that PLMC does not provide transfers between Kuala Lumpur International Airport and Berjaya Times Square KL.

You may book your flights even before registration starts. When making your flight arrangements, please note that you are required to be at Berjaya Times Square KL by 5pm on 14 June 2026, and Ohana Camp will end after lunch at 2pm on 17 June 2026.

22. Can I drive to the camp location? Is parking available at the hotel?

Yes, you may opt to **drive** to Kuala Lumpur. Please allow yourself at least six hours of travel time, including time for rest stops, meals and toilet breaks. Do plan to arrive at Berjaya Times Square KL by 5pm on 14 June 2026. Please be reminded that you need to be issued the Vehicle Entry Permit and Road Charge in order to drive Singapore-registered vehicles in Malaysia.

Parking is available at the hotel for campers. The parking rates are as follows:

Please note that if guests leave the carpark and return, they will be charged again upon re-entry. Payment is by Touch'n Go card or credit card only. For parking above four hours, campers will need to validate their carpark coupon at the hotel reception for the 24-hour flat rate to apply.

Please note that if campers park their cars throughout the entire duration of the camp (that is, enter the carpark on 14 June and exit on 17 June without leaving the carpark and re-entering), a flat rate of **RM16** will be charged upon exit on 17 June.

23. What is the programme for the camp like? Will there be a camp briefing?

There will be a camp briefing on 24 May 2026 or 7 June 2026. At least one member per booking or family unit needs to be present at the briefing.

24. Is participation in all activities mandatory?

We strongly encourage you to join in all the activities and get to know other campers, so that you can enjoy a fun, meaningful, and well-rounded camp experience.

25. Can I make my own accommodation arrangements and just join the programme?

The church camp is a time for members and worshippers to come together as a family and community, to foster deeper love for God, your family and the wider church family. That is why we hope families, cell groups, even clusters and ministry groups, will sign up and join the camp together. Hence in order, for you to have a seamless immersive Ohana experience, we strongly encourage you to participate fully. This includes staying in and getting to fellowship together for a holistic and meaningful camp experience.

26. Is there a dress code for the worship services and speaker sessions?

While there is no specified dress code, do dress modestly and comfortably.

Cancellations and Amendments

27. I made a mistake during registration! Is it possible for me to update my details or add in additional participants after already making payment?

28. If I am unable to make the trip due to unforeseen circumstances, what are the cancellation charges?

In line with the hotel's and transport operator's cancellation and refund policies, for cancellations received in writing:

- a. Before 31 March 2026 – Full refund of accommodation and transport charges
- b. 1 April to 15 May 2026 – 40% refund of accommodation, full refund for transport charges
- c. From 16 May 2026 – No refund of accommodation or transport charges

For peace of mind, campers are advised to ensure they have adequate personal travel insurance coverage that will take care of trip cancellations, delays, medical emergencies, lost or stolen belongings and emergency evacuations.

29. How will the refund be made? When can I expect to receive payment?

Refunds will be made within 30 days upon approval through PayNow.
