# Blessed by the Watoto Children's Choir



On January 25, the Watoto Children's Choir from Uganda visited the Silver Boxes Children's Ministry for a meaningful morning focused on friendship, worship, and the enduring promise of God's love. While the choir has performed here previously, this specific visit was designed as a time of heartfelt ministry with interactive segments to help our children know that despite challenges they may face, they can always forward to "Better Days" ahead with our God.



The choir kicked off the session with a time of worship, followed by high-energy games that filled the Haven with infectious laughter. The time of traditional African dancing saw enthusiastic participation from our Silver Boxes children, who enjoyed experiencing a vibrant new culture firsthand. The atmosphere turned reflective as a young boy from the choir shared his moving testimony of being abandoned at birth and finding hope and a family through Watoto, beautifully illustrating the truth of Jeremiah 29:11.

Other stories followed, each as earnest and inspiring as the last.

The session concluded with a powerful moment of unity as everyone held hands to pray for the children in Uganda and for the nation of Singapore.

It was an eye-opening session for our Silver Boxes children, many of whom were eager to share the stories they've heard of God's goodness and sovereignty with their families.

# PLMC Kairos Youth Camp: For Such a Time as This



The Youth Camp 2025 brought together a total of over 70 students aged 13 to 18 and their leaders for a powerful encounter centered on the theme "Kairos", which was inspired by Esther 4:14.

Throughout the two-day camp (30-31 Dec 2025), the youths explored what it means to live according to God's divine appointed timing and how to say "yes" to His invitation to be part of a larger Kingdom story.

Packed with intentional moments of connection, from morning devotionals and high-energy games to reflection sessions, the youths saw God's hand over them and PLMC over the past three years. A defining highlight occurred during the final ministry session with guest speaker Mr. Wayne Sim, where nearly every camp participant moved to the altar in a beautiful act of surrender. This collective response was more than just a momentary feeling; it was a personal and group commitment to a lifetime of following God's lead.

May the seeds of faith that have been planted take deep root in our youths and bear much fruit in His perfect timing, and may they shine for Him in the places and seasons He has planned for them,
